



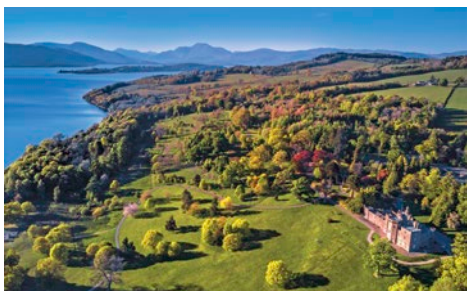

A World of Discovery

Stirling. Stirling lies in the heart of a very historic area of Scotland. On a guided tour, visit the site of the Battle of Bannockburn, and hear the story of the Scots' triumph in this 14th-century battle in the war for independence. Next, explore grand Stirling Castle, an important stronghold and royal residence, as well as the coronation site of Mary, Queen of Scots. See the Great Hall and royal chambers, and then spend some free time on the grounds.

Edinburgh & the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo. On your route to Edinburgh, see the Forth Bridge, the oldest multispan cantilever bridge. After arriving in Scotland's dynamic capital, take in the medieval Old Town and the Georgian New Town. Stroll later with your guide on the lively, atmospheric Royal Mile and visit Edinburgh Castle high atop Castle Rock. Then, delight in the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo, an unforgettable annual spectacle performed before the floodlit castle that features regimental pipes and drums, Highland dancers and fireworks. *(Active)*

Scone Palace & Glenturret Distillery. In Perth, enjoy a guided visit at Scone Palace, the ancient coronation site of Scottish monarchs including Robert the Bruce. Admire the beautiful period rooms and grounds. Enter the Murray Star Maze and see if you can find your way out! Head next to Crieff and tour Glenturret Distillery, Scotland's oldest working distillery. Learn about their traditional methods of making fine whisky and savor a tasting.

Loch Lomond & The Trossachs.

Relish the splendid scenery of this vast national park known for its pristine lochs and munros, or mountains. Begin with a cruise on Loch Lomond and stop later in Luss, a pretty village filled with slate and sandstone cottages originally built for workers at the nearby slate quarries. After lunch along the lakeshore, enjoy a scenic drive through Aberfoyle and Queen Elizabeth Forest Park in the Trossachs.

St Andrews. Stop to see the impressive National Wallace Monument erected in honor of William Wallace on your way to St Andrews. Once there, walk with your guide amid the seaside ruins of its medieval castle and envision the grandeur of its 12th-century cathedral from the remnants that still stand. Continue to the celebrated St Andrews Old Course, where golf has been played for more than 600 years. Enjoy some free time afterward in the vibrant, historic town center.
