ITINERARY

April 11: Tokyo, Japan - Embark 1pm 🏠

Embark in Tokyo, where centuries-old temples and modern high-rises share the skyline.

April 12: Cruising the Pacific Ocean

A day at sea offers a relaxing change of pace. Attend an expert talk that deepens cultural context, read on deck while watching the horizon shift, or settle in for an exquisite dining experience, inspired by the regions along the route.

April 13: Wakayama, Japan

Set along the Kii Peninsula's forested coastline, Wakayama features fishing boats along the harbor, trains lining the shore, and hillside temples that recall a long-standing role as a gateway to sacred pilgrimage routes through cedar forests and stone-paved paths.

April 14: Kochi, Japan

Sun-lit and Pacific-facing, Kochi boasts open skies and a relaxed coastal atmosphere. Mountains rise close to the coast, and clear rivers cut through the town, where Kochi Castle still stands at the city's center.

April 15: Kagoshima, Japan

Kagoshima stretches along a broad bay beneath an active volcano, visible from nearly everywhere in the city. Ferries cross the water throughout the day, while historic gardens and hot springs reflect long-standing regional traditions.

April 16: Nagasaki, Japan

From the harbor, compact Nagasaki rises uphill. European-built churches and former trading districts reflect centuries of foreign presence. At the same time, atomic bomb memorials and preserved ruins appear alongside homes and schools, tying World War II history directly to this modern city.

April 17: Jeju, South Korea

Formed by ancient lava flows, Jeju's coastline alternates between black rock and open sea. Stone walls border farm plots, fishermen tend to their nets along the harbor's breakwaters, and UNESCO-listed natural landscapes include Hallasan Mountain at the island's center.

April 18-19: Shanghai, China

Spreading inland from the Huangpu River, Shanghai is made up of early twentieth-century neighborhoods, residential lanes, and commercial districts. In this dynamic city, tall London plane trees cast shade across wide streets, tai chi fills neighborhood parks, and the world's fastest commercial electric train moves through the city.

April 20: Cruising the East China Sea

Cruising the East China Sea offers time to slow the pace and settle into the rhythm of the voyage. Enjoy a day onboard with time for reflection, learning, and onboard enrichment.

April 21: Ishigaki, Japan 📍

Subtropical and culturally distinct, Ishigaki sits between coral reefs and sugarcane fields. Clear, turquoise waters support local fishing, while markets feature seaweed, tuna, and local beef alongside the island's Ryukyu food traditions.

April 22: Taipei (Keelung), Taiwan

Set against steep green hills, Keelung is shaped by frequent rain and maritime activity. Along the waterfront, fishing boats return with the morning tide. Nearby markets open early, tying the morning catch directly to neighborhood kitchens and street stalls.

April 23: Cruising the South China Sea

A second day at sea allows time for relaxation and further onboard enrichment. Join a cooking demonstration, linger over conversation with fellow travelers, or settle into a shaded lounge and take in uninterrupted views of the South China Sea.

April 24: Hong Kong, China - Disembark 8am 📍

Disembark in Hong Kong, a fitting conclusion to a journey tracing historic sea routes across East Asia.
