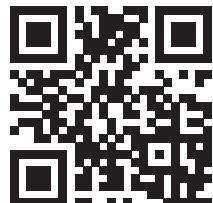

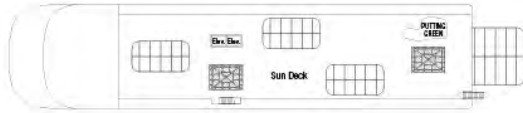
DINING
