**Day 1 | February 1****D**

Depart | Philipsburg,
St. Maarten | Embark

Depart your home city for Philipsburg, St. Maarten, where you will embark the *Sea Cloud Spirit*.

Day 2 | February 2 **B-L-R-D**

Gustavia, St. Barthélemy

In beautiful Gustavia, St. Barthélemy, choose between two excursions. Snorkel in the calm, turquoise waters at remote Colombier Beach, where you might see starfish, sea turtles, stingrays, sea urchins, moray eels and lobsters. Or enjoy a scenic drive around the tiny, beautiful island of St. Barts, with its white-sand beaches, forested hills, red-roofed houses and seaside villages. Stop at picture-perfect Saint-Jean Bay and wrap up at Gustavia, where you can browse the boutiques, enjoy a cold drink and do some people-watching. Join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner on board the ship this evening.

Day 3 | February 3**B-L-D**

Cabrits, Dominica

In Dominica, the “Nature Isle of the Caribbean,” disembark after lunch for your choice between four excursions. Hike lush trails in Cabrits National Park, which encompasses protected habitats ranging from rainforests to coral reefs. Explore Fort Shirley, a historic fort built by the British in 1765 that has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site. Or ride in a rowboat along the Indian River, which runs from deep in the tropical forest out to the Caribbean Sea. You’ll see

mangroves, iconic local bwa mang trees, dozens of exotic birds and possibly crabs, fish and iguanas. Or choose between two rainforest hikes — one to sulfur springs and a waterfall, the other to search for endangered parrots.

Day 4 | February 4 **B-L-D**

Port Elizabeth |
Bequia, Grenadines

Disembark in beautiful Bequia (pronounced Beck-way), one of the islands in the Grenadines island chain. Visit Princess Margaret Beach, a stunning white-sand crescent fringed with lush palms. Enjoy strolling along the beach, or swimming

and snorkeling in the calm, clear water.

Day 5 | February 5 B-L-D

Soufrière, St. Lucia

Wake this morning to stunning tropical views of St. Lucia. Two famous, dramatically pointed mountains stand guard over the lush, idyllic island. Gros and Petit Piton are actually (extinct) volcanic cones and have been designated as UNESCO World Heritage sites. Disembark for your choice excursion. Visit the world's only drive-in volcano, part of the same complex as the Pitons. The volcano is extinct, but mud still bubbles and sulfurous steam floats in the air

in this otherworldly spot. Next, explore the lush gardens of the Morne Coubaril Historical Park or go for an invigorating hike. Or choose to unwind at Sugar Beach, where the crystal-clear waters — filled with a kaleidoscope of vibrant marine life — are ideal for swimming or snorkeling. Return to the ship for lunch and spend the afternoon at leisure on board.

Day 6 | February 6 B-L-D

St. George's, Grenada

Grenada is home to verdant rainforests, beautiful beaches, aromatic spice plantations and cocoa farms. Today, take a tasting tour of Grenada. Visit Laura Herb and Spice

Garden, a botanical garden focused on medicinal herbs and spices. Tour the grounds with a private guide and learn about the fascinating trees, herbs and spices grown here, including coconut, nutmeg, mace, allspice, cinnamon, vanilla, turmeric and cloves. Or hike in a protected tropical rainforest situated around a crater lake in an extinct volcano. This reserve boasts stunning scenery and rich biodiversity — look out for Mona monkeys, emerald hummingbirds and other birdlife, and rare orchids during your hike. Or simply relax at Grand Anse Beach, famous for its white sand and calm turquoise water.

Day 7 | February 7 B-L-D

Day at Sea

Spend today at your leisure. Attend a fascinating lecture, savor three delicious meals, and of course, delight in the beautiful views gliding by.

Day 8 | February 8 B-L-R-D

Kralendijk, Bonaire

Enjoy breakfast on board this morning as the ship arrives in Bonaire. The island's geography is varied, ranging from forested green hills to

desert-like salt pans dotted with cacti and flocks of pink flamingos. Bonaire also boasts rocky cliffs, mangrove forests and a long offshore coral reef that makes it a famous destination for scuba divers. Choose to explore Gotomeer, a salt-water lagoon known for its flamingo population. Bring along your binoculars and cameras as you search for the shy, leggy birds. Or snorkel at Klein Bonaire, a small, uninhabited islet with beautiful beaches, clear water and a profusion of colorful

marine life. Or go kayaking in a protected mangrove preserve. Join your fellow travelers for a Farewell Reception and Dinner on board the ship this evening and raise a glass to your luxurious week in paradise!

Day 9 | February 9 B

Willemstad, Curaçao | Disembark ship | Return to home city

After breakfast, disembark and transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

Catching the Wind



After a fabled life (including a stint in World War II!), *Sea Cloud* has been restored and again sails the seas, along with siblings *Sea Cloud II* and *Sea Cloud Spirit*.

Your captain and crew are committed to using the wind to sail whenever possible, which makes for an unparalleled passenger experience. Watch as the deckhands climb the rigging (some 190 feet above the sea!), loosen the heavy sails and haul lines in from the deck. As the sails catch the wind, you'll feel your spirits — and the *Spirit* itself — lift and soar.
